To remove administrative burden from our provider partners, In 2019, Aetna Better Health of Kentucky removed notification requirements for **Well Newborns (DRG 795)** during the first 4 days of life for participating providers. Well newborns can stay 4 days, post-partum even if the mom is discharged prior to the newborn.

However, if the well newborn (DRG 795) exceeds the 4 days or **if a newborn requires higher level care, a prior authorization is required.**

A neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) also known as an intensive care nursery (ICN) specializes in the care of ill or premature newborn infants. ABHKY authorizes NICU facility levels by assignment of an authorized revenue code(s) to a provider for NICU room and board stay. If a NICU facility level is submitted on the UB-04 claim form with a revenue code that is at a higher level of care than the revenue code authorized, the reimbursement for the NICU will be at the level authorized.
